Soft spikes are mandatory. Proper attire required.

Areas surrounding Somerset are a natural habitat for the Great Basin rattlesnake. Be aware.

Points of Interest

The Canyon Nine is designed with a different methodology than the 18 Hole Championship Course.

Tom Kite envisioned a series of controlled hitting areas rather than the traditional tee boxes. You will notice these areas denoted on all holes. Varying your tee off location will help reduce extreme wear and tear to isolated tees. Holes #5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 each incorporate two separate hitting areas to appeal to different levels of play. Hole #9 is the course's signature hole encompassing a beautiful water feature.
